DATE TO BE ENTERED IN ECLECTIC

BOOK BEFORE PLAYING. 9-Hole scorecards to be used.

Card number and page number to noted on each card and an NR to be recorded.

2. The first card **must** be completed. A score **must** be recorded for every hole on the first card.
3. Eclectic cards not to be played in conjunction with any other competition. Only one eclectic card may be returned on any one day.
