### Note

Significant number of members cannot correctly mark a card for this type of competition, therefore expect difference between cards and computer results

See Supplementary Note on handicap adjustment since members may query how it is calculated. Pro Shop system calculates the scoring.

A Par/Bogey Competition is based on whether the player (after handicap allowance)

1. beats the par of the hole (+)
2. equals the par (0)
3. loses to the par (-)

The handicap adjustment is not dependent on by how much the hole is won or lost.

It should be noted that the handicap adjustment following a par/bogey competition may be different from a handicap adjustment if the result was to be calculated on a medal or stableford scoring system.

## MID-WEEK COMPETITIONS

These are Competitions open to all 18H Playing members

Two Competitions are held each month - one early in the month and the other late in the month. Days Tuesday Mixed & Friday individual.

It is intended that eight monthly competitions will be medals and four monthly competitions will be stableford. Specific months will be agreed by Competitions Committee.

Each Division is treated as a separate competition and entry fees are allocated to the appropriate division.

50% entry fees for each division to the Club.

Balance 2/3<sup>rd</sup> to division winner 1/3<sup>rd</sup> division runner up

The committee may at its discretion combine some or all of the divisions.
