FORMAT:	9-hole competition (holes 1 – 9) <i>Course Handicap allowance -</i> $\frac{1}{4}$ of course handicap (at close of the competition) to be deducted. Six cards from 1 st Sept to 31 st October
HANDICAP INDEX LIMITS:	None

1. Entry fee must be paid in the Pro Shop before playing first card. DATE TO BE ENTERED IN ECLECTIC BOOK BEFORE PLAYING. Special 'eclectic' cards to be used. Card number and page number to be noted on each card and an NR to be recorded.
2. The first card **must** be completed. A score **must** be recorded for every hole on the first card.
3. Eclectic cards not to be played in conjunction with any other competition. Only one eclectic card may be returned on any one day.
4. All nine holes must be played each time and in the proper sequence. (This does not mean every hole has to be completed if a score cannot be bettered).
5. Each Player is responsible for entering her scores on the eclectic page. Subsequent improvements should be clearly entered. Eclectic pages and scorecards will be checked. Player is also responsible for entering her final gross score.

HANDICAP INDEX LIMITS:	None

1. Entry fee must be paid to the Pro Shop before playing first card. DATE TO BE ENTERED IN ECLECTIC BOOK BEFORE PLAYING. Special 'eclectic' cards to be used.

Card number and page number to noted on each card and an NR to be recorded.
2. The first card **must** be completed. A score **must** be recorded for every hole on the first card.
3. Eclectic cards not to be played in conjunction with any other competition. Only one eclectic card may be returned on any one day.
4. All nine holes must be played each time and in the proper sequence. (This does not mean every hole has to be completed if a score cannot be bettered).

3. The entry fee to be paid in the Pro Shop before playing the first card. Intent to play each card must be recorded in the Pro Shop and completed cards returned to the box in the ladies cloakroom for the Committee to record results on eclectic sheet.
4. 50% of course handicap (at close of competition) to be deducted.
5. Countback on 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole.
6. Prizes according to entry.

HANDICAP INDEX LIMITS: Silver division +0.4 to 17.2
