

# Bury St Edmunds Golf Club Dress Code



## ACCEPTABLE ON THE COURSES

**Shirts: Men:** high/low collared & sleeved. **Ladies:** high/low collared & sleeved/sleeveless

**Trousers/Shorts: Men:** knee length tailored shorts or long trousers. **Ladies:** long trousers/knee length shorts/skorts/skirts

**Socks:** Knee length, mid-calf or ankle sports socks

**Shoes: 18 hole:** Golf shoes only  
**9 hole:** Golf shoes or trainers

## UNACCEPTABLE ON THE COURSES

**NO** voice use of mobile telephones except in medical emergencies

**Shirts: NO** t-shirts, vests or track-suits

**Trousers/Shorts: NO** beach shorts or cargo shorts

**Socks: NO** rolled down socks

**Shoes: NO** trainers or improper Golf shoes on 18-hole

## IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Dress standard for the clubhouse is as for the 18-hole course EXCEPT:

- Smart denim jeans are permitted
- Shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse
- **NO** flip-flops or bare feet
- Caps and hats should be removed
- Casual shoes, trainers and sandals
- Mobiles and laptops allowed on silent
- Spiked golf shoes are **ONLY ALLOWED** in the Spike Bar
- There is a designated area outside for smoking and e-cigs **NOT** on the terrace

If a member believes that another member or guest is not following the rules in the Clubhouse then the issue should be drawn to the attention of the Manager, Bar Manager or Deputies who will endeavour to deal with the problem in a way that avoids embarrassment.
